# **Parent Questionnaire July 2025**

Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete our recent parent questionnaire. Your feedback is very important to us and helps shape the ongoing development of our school.

### **Key Findings**

Happiness and Safety: The vast majority of parents say their child is happy and feels safe at school.

Behaviour and Expectations: Most parents are positive about behaviour and the high expectations we set for pupils.

**Curriculum and Opportunities**: There is strong satisfaction with the range of subjects, clubs, and wider opportunities on offer.

**Achievement and Progress**: Nearly all parents feel their child is doing well at school and that staff have high expectations for them.

**SEND Support**: Parents of children with additional needs largely feel they are well supported.

Recommendation: The overwhelming majority of parents would recommend the school to others.

## **Development Points and Next Steps**

Communication About Learning: Some parents would like even clearer and more regular updates on what their child is learning and how they are progressing.

### What we will do:

From next term, we will provide termly achievement reports for each child, giving you a clear picture of their progress and where they are at that point in the year.

We are currently creating learning journeys for each subject, explaining what will be taught and when. These will be accessible on the school website.

We will continue to publish class newsletters on the website every term, to keep you informed of activities and curriculum highlights.

Dealing with Concerns & Bullying: A small number of parents would like to see greater consistency in how we respond to concerns, especially in relation to bullying.

#### What we will do:

We are reviewing our procedures to ensure every parent knows what to expect and who to contact if there are any worries.

Our staff will receive updated training so that all concerns are addressed promptly and sensitively.

We will improve communication with parents about actions taken in response to reported incidents.

Activities and Enrichment: A few parents would like to see an even wider range of clubs and enrichment activities.

#### What we will do:

We will survey pupils to find out which clubs, activities, or new subjects most interest them.

We will publish an extended list of all our clubs and enrichment opportunities on the website at the start of each term.
